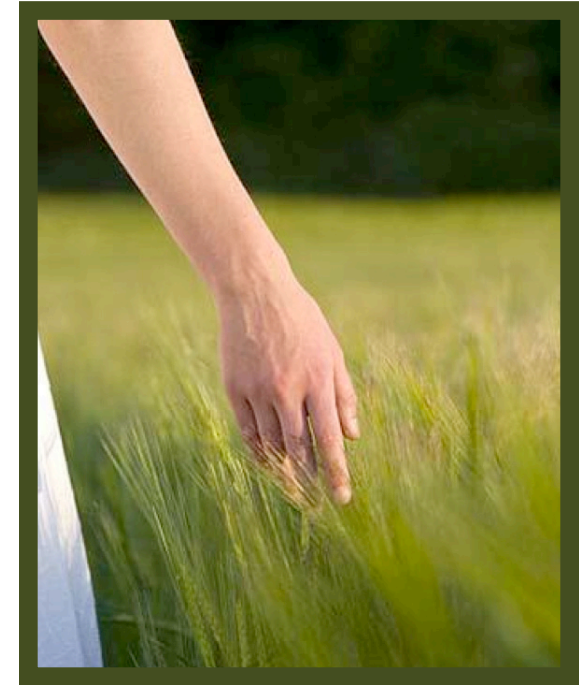

RETREAT LEADER

FATHER RICH LUBERTI, CSSR



Fr. Rich Luberti, C.Ss.R, acting pastor for St. Joseph's Church in Maybee, Michigan and associate with the American Sign Language Liturgy Project in the Archdiocese of Atlanta, will lead a retreat for the Deaf Community in Wichita on Saturday, October 22, 2011. The retreat, titled "Walking with God,"

is sponsored by The Ministry with Persons with Disabilities in the Diocese of Wichita and will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Magnificat Center located at 3700 East Lincoln in Wichita.

Fr. Luberti had learned some sign as a young man and volunteered at St. John's School for the Deaf in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He was ordained a Redemptorist priest in 1979. After working in "hearing" parishes for many years, Fr. Luberti joined with Fr. Len Broniak and formed a "Southern Redemptorist Mission Team" to serve the needs of the Deaf Community. They were based in San Antonio, Texas but worked throughout North America. They spent a month working with the deaf in the islands of Trinidad and Tobago and gave a presentation at the International Catholic Foundation for the Service of Deaf Persons in Spain. Fr. Luberti has worked with the Catholic Deaf Community in Toronto, Canada, Lafayette, Louisiana, Baton Rouge, Louisiana and Gulfport, Mississippi.
